L. H. Chapman took sick with Flu, Dec. 15, 1932. Couldn't eat or sleep. Suffered awfully until Feb. 22, 1933, and died, being 67 years 4 months and 22 days. Was buried Wright graveyard. funeral preached by Bro. Tom Locky. He was visited by a host of friends and a great crowd attended the funeral which was preached in Salem Church Hill.

Earnest Chapman was operated on for ulcerated stomach in Pulaski Nov. the 15, 1932. took Pneumonia the 17th died the same day about 10 o'clock. was buried the 1st New Hope graveyard near Cornersville Tenn. Earnest was 40 years 6 months and 19 days old.
