If you don't know what this section is all about then go back and read page 23 in issue #23, fall 1990. I've made two minor changes. The person's name is at the top of each piece and my comments are identified more clearly.

Donald V. Chapman #004 DVC Decatur IL

I am enclosing my Chapman family worksheet, which you will see takes my family back one more generation, with the addition of JAMES CHAPMAN and his wife Rebecca RAD-CLIFF. He was my 2nd great grandfather. He and his wife are both buried in cemeteries near Decatur, Illinois. See page 11 of CHAPMAN CHATTER No 23.

I would like to hear from any of their descendants who might be able to fill me in on any of their early history. They lived in Jackson and Sciota counties, in Ohio, before they moved to Illinois.

James and Rebecca had 10 children. They were Lorane, Ann, William, Robert R. (who was my great grandfather) and Andrew J., Joseph, Catherine, Leathe, Susan, and Sarah J. Andrew and his family were the first to move to Macon Co Illinois, around 1850, and James and Rebecca came sometime later... I may not have these children listed in the proper order.

I will appreciate any help any one can give me about these ancestors of mine.

Gil's Comments: An updated lineage appears in the "Chapman Lineages" section and those persons not listed earlier in the "Biographical Reference" section have been added to it with the 004-DVC reference. I failed to notice when the lineage was printed in the previous issue that this "complete" line was published in CHAPMAN LINEAGES, VOL I. The majority of the data came from Kay

I'm enclosing a check for the <u>Chapman Lineages</u>, <u>Vol 1</u>. I presume that that is a separate publication from the "Chatter", and you plan to publish 4 "Chatters" during the year?

I haven't found anything new on the family. Still searching for info on Samuel in VA. I sent you a check last June for the "Chatters". Let me know when that subscription is up. Keep up the good work.

PS Gil, just noticed the comp page of A. L. Chapman - he said (Sr) JOHN CHAPMAN's wife was NANCY WHITEHEAD. I though it was Anne might want to check with him & see. I will write him too & double check that.

Gil's Comments: Yes, there will still be "4 Chatters" per year and they will be just packed with data as is this one. If I lived to be 200 years old I could never print all the Chapman information in just the newsletters. I will supplement the newsletters with the Lineage publications, and probably some others, as frequently as I can put them together. Every one's subscription will be up after the next issue (unless you signed on for two years).

I'm not sure what it was that Lavern saw that she refers to about Ann vs Nancy. We have been writing about Miss Whitehead's first name ever since Laverne's letter of June 13 1986. My latest "computer genealogy" shows John Sr. married (1) Ann Whitehead and (2) Oney League. The latter was December 21 1799. I have information, however, that strongly

suggests "Nancy". One item is a letter dated November 13 1895 from Cynthia Chapman Morrison. She wrote, "My great grandmother names before they was married was Edith Wilson, and Nancy Whitehead and Mary Coleman and Elizabeth Lyon. I think they was all from England. My grandfather Chapman's mother was Nancy Whitehead." It is quite probable that she was Nancy Ann or Nancy Anne Whitehead. I asked Dr. Al Chapman what he knew about it in a Prodigy message.

Gil's Comments: The directory, which includes Molly's very short Chapman line, was mailed to Tucson. It will be a wonder though if I don't screw up some of the mailing with these folks who have seasonal addresses.

#### GREG BOLT #043-GLB Slidell LA

I first wrote to you in May 1990 asking for information on my Chapman line, back beyond WILLIAM CHAPMAN b. 1809 in Cumberland Co KY. I have since received letters from Noni Sawyer #019 and Jean Brown #000 who both have Chapman ancestors from that part of KY. From information gathered on a trip to Cumberland Co, and their letters, it now appears that the most probable father of William was GEORGE CHAPMAN b. 4 Dec 1770, the son of GEORGE CHAPMAN, b. 25 Dec 1736, and DIANA DURRETT, who are on p. 3 of your 1985 Chapman Directory.

From Noni's Durrett Family information, Jean Brown's letter, and Cumberland Co information, it appears that both GEORGE CHAPMAN and his brother ASA CHAPMAN were living in Cumberland Co in the early 1800's and probably died there (your 1985 Chapman Directory indicates several of this family died in Warren Co. Do you have the information on which ones?) George and Asa owned land on both sides of the Cumberland River with Asa on the North side adjoining Rock House (a natural bridge we visited) and George owning land on the South side. This area is just a few miles downstream from the current Cumberland Lake dam. Their names show up frequently in Cumberland Co Court records, jury records, and surveying records and associated with the names listed in the Durrett paper with the Chapman sisters, ie. Charles Thomas, William Higgins. There does appear to be several Asa's, possibly both named sons Asa.

The Durrett information shows 7 children of George and Diana, the two brothers George and Asa, and 5 sisters, Frances D, Elizabeth, Nancy (Ann), Margaret and Polly. Nine children are shown for Asa, but none named William. No information is given for George's family. If you do not have this Durrett Family information from the <u>VIRGINIA GENEALOGIST</u>, I can copy it if you are interested.

At this point I have no information on wife or children of George, b. 1770. Jean Brown says he died in 1830 in Cumberland Co. Census records of 1810 show 1 m and 1 f both under 10, and 1830 shows George living alone.

Now for likely connection to my William Chapman: considerable court records of Samuel Elliott's estate settlement for over 10 years in the late 1820's show his daughter Polly (Mary) married to a WILLIAM CHAPMAN. The bottom area where George owned across the river from Rock HOuse was known as Elliott's bottom around 1800 for Samuel Elliott before it became known

as Well's bottom.

Again, you may be able to straighten out errors I may be making, or may now be able to provide some additional information.

Also, can you provide recent addresses for the following: Wilmont R. Layne [#000] Theron L. Smith [#000]

Mrs. Smiley Blanton [don't know]
Thanks again for your help. I
am optimistic that I am getting close
to completing this link.

Gil's Comment: There was a mistake in the earlier directory. The children died in Barren County, not Warren County. I've responded by separate letter. I could not provide a later date for the three folks listed. The first two are old Chappies- I've never heard of the third. Based on all I think I know about this family I prepared a family group record on George Chapman. It will be found elsewhere in this issue.

I am happy to be receiving the <u>CHAPMAN CHATTER</u>. Please find enclosed an updated copy of my research. You'll note that I have successfully pushed the family genealogy back another generation and found three siblings of my 2X greatgrandfather who were previously unknown to me.

I have determined that HENRY

CHAPMAN and ABAGAIL SOWARDS are FRANKLIN CHAPMAN's parents. Death records and the estate records of ABAGAIL SOWARDS CHAPMAN in Tiffin, Ohio confirm this. Her husband Henry, who was born in New York state, was dead by the time the 1880 Census (Huron County; Norwich Township; EDN 151, Sheet B) was taken. Is it possible that my Henry is related to any of the following Henry's listed in the CHAPMAN CHATTER?

CC #22, page 10 Summer 1990

There are two Henry's listed as residents of Ontario County, New York in 1820 and one of them also in 1840.

CC #23, page 38 Fall 1990

DOR 074 DORIS PALMER JOHN HENRY born 18101214 in NY Mont.

BJK 075 BERNICE KAYE HENRY A. born 1820?

You mentioned on page 5 of the last CHAPMAN CHATTER your interest in learning more about the computers being used by your readers. Gil's Comments: I can't add to the 1820 Henry's in Ontario Co NY. Maybe a reader can. All readers should make a pen and ink change on the Mrs. vs Rev. on page 38 in the last issue. A corrected listing is included in the Active Chappies list in this issue. I've updated the computer file.

Bernice Kaye's #075 HENRY A. CHAPMAN was born June 17 1820 and died June 20 1865, in Chestnut Hill Hospital in Philadelphia. He died at age 45 of "valvular disease of heart." His occupation on the death certificate which Bernice sent shows he was a soldier.

Doris Palmer's #074 JOHN HENRY CHAPMAN was born December 14 1810 in Montgomery Co. NY and he died 1872. He was a boatman from the Danube in Herkimer Co. [NY] (Erie Canal). It is possible that John Henry's father was DAVID CHAPMAN.

Since I last wrote I have uncovered only a little more information about RALPH CHAPMAN who was born 17 Jan 1781 Conn., marr. 18 May 1802, died 22 Apr 1851, buried in Poolville NY.

In the 1850 census of Hamilton, Madison Co., NY I found Ralph in a second marriage. His first wife died in 1840. The census showed him married to Angeline, age 36 born in New York. The first child listed with the family was a boy, but the name was difficult to read -- it looked like Lurendon, Surendon or Suvendon. He was 9 years old, born in New York. The second child was a girl, Helen J. age 1, also born in New York. I am unable to know whether she had been a widow with children or whether he was the natural father. His occupation was laborer.

Perhaps there are some descendants of the children of this second marriage who may have information on Ralph. If I could locate the city of his birth I may lock into a wealth of information as Connecticut has published many vital records. I am enclosing a years subscription to CHAPMAN CHATTER. I hope this will be mutually beneficial.

Gil's Comments: Gwynne's lineage was published on page 18 in the Summer 1990 [#22] issue. I have unanswered, backlogged correspondence older than the letter she mentioned- and I didn't move, break a foot, or have a baby. Wow! what a few months that must have been for her.

#### CONNECTING CHAPPIES

At the end of Edward C. McKinney's, 003-ECM comments on page 24 in the last issue I mentioned a discovery concerning his ADONIJAH CHAPMAN. His lineage had been printed on page 17 in issue #22 and stopped at ADONIJAH CHAPMAN. While working with some family group records that Mike "Chapman" Morgan sent I found Adonijah and his connection to an established branch- WILLIAM CHAPMAN on New London CT. A revised lineage has been included in this issue. The "new" names from Mike's family group records have been added to the Biographical Reference.

The following was received from Dorothy Wogh, 080-DAW Napa CA.

Enclosed please find a copy of information I sent Delmoine Shepherd 076-DS2, regarding MELVENA CHAP-MAN and Upton HAGAR. According to 1850 census of Woodford Co. Malvena was living with her father and had the children with her. She is listed as Chapman on the census. I assume Upton died altho the man that did the research did not find any death notices in Woodford Co., KY.

After looking at these papers I can see where I made a lot of mistakes, but this was my first project on Roots 3.

I would appreciate any information you can give me on my Chapmans.

[The following is a transcript of the letter she sent Delmoine.]

I see where you asked for information on ABNER CHAPMAN in

the <u>CHAPMAN CHATTER</u> Fall 1990 which I just received today. I am sending you some information that I have about Abner and Malvena. According to the 1850 census Abner was born in Va. same as Malvena, but Anthony, Abners son, was born in KY. I have the marriage license of Malvena to Upton HAGAR if you would like a copy I will send it to you. I would appreciate getting a copy of the will of JOSEPH G. CHAPMAN brother of Melvena. I have not done research past Abner, but I believe that he might have come from Caroline County of VA.

I am sure that Malvena is buried in the family cemetery at Arcola Ill. because it said M. F. Hagar, and the age would be about right. I have not been able to get the death certificates for either David or Malvena, but maybe if I try again in Tuscola instead of Arcola I will have better luck. When we were in Illinois in 1980 we did get pictures of the grave, and I also got the information from the Town Hall about the cemetery plot. They sure were scared I was going to ask about the plot because they told us real quick that the plot was filled up. There are some Stoneburners buried there, but they must not be any relations because they come from Ohio. That information sure got me on the wrong track.

I believe that there were some Ritchies the family wrote about, but I would have to go back and check all my information. Seems like they were on the Whitaker side, Caroline's second husband. One of the letters Jennie wrote to my grandmother Lulu about their sister Gertrude who had TB mentioned the grandparents R. I have always wondered who this

might have been.

I would appreciate any help that you can give me, and will be only too glad to share what I have given you. I have been working hard on my Humphries line that I haven't had much time to work on other lines. I also believe that I will find out that ALICE CHAPMAN from NC was also a grandparent, but that remains to be proved. I have always wondered where I got my middle name Alice, and it looks like it maybe a family name even tho my mother never knew it. My grandfather Myers had a sister named Alice so mom always let me believe I was named for her. One name that I do know is a family name but I don't know where it comes from is Frances. Both my mother and Caroline Petty said that they were told it was a family name. Don't know if Malvenas's middle name was Frances, but her initials were M. F.

Will close for this time, and hope that we can share what information we each have.

I am enclosing my family sheets, but I notice that I did not include Anthony's [or Joseph's] name on Abner's sheet. I was just learning how to use my Roots 3 program when I typed up my family group sheets.

Gils Comments: Readers will find Delmoine's inquiry on page 18 in the last issue. Dorothy sent a stack of family group records, a pedigree and a copy of the letter (above) she had sent to Delmoine. Dorothy's lineage is printed in the "Chapman Lineage" section. Dorothy is a great grand-daughter of MELVENA CHAPMAN. Dorothy was a HUDSON before marriage. Other surnames in her line between Chapman and Hudson are HAGAR, HUMPHRIES, and MYERS for those who might be interested.

While this does not add to either's information it does establish a connection between two Chappies. Note that Dorothy, one of our senior Chappies, is using a computer and trying out new software (Roots III).

#### Sceva Chapman

This is a continuation of the article started in issue ‡ 22 in the Summer of 1990. CHESLEY G. CHAPMAN was the subject of that article. In the original article sentences run to paragraphs and paragraphs run to pages. Some paragraphing has been added just to give readers a break.

Sceva Chapman, grandfather of Chesley G. Chapman, was born in Cavendish, Windsor county, Vermont, on February 10, 1793, and thus he was about twenty-five years of age at the time of the family removal to Medina county, Ohio. Before leaving the old Green Mountain state it had been his to render valiant service as a soldier in the war of 1812, in which he was a member of a company commanded by Captain Asa Aikens, in the Thirty-first Regiment, United States Infantry. On February 17, 1825, he was united in marriage to Miss Azuba Marsh, of Ashland county, Ohio. His wife, who was the daughter of Abijah and Bersha (Snow) Marsh, who moved from Massachusetts to Vermont in 1794, was born at Wardsbury, Windham county, Vermont, on October 7, 1802, and was a member of the third family to make permanent settlement in Medina township, Medina county, Ohio, where they made their advent on November 7, 1816.

Sceva Chapman became a man of prominence and influence in the pioneer community and was called upon to serve in various offices of public trust and responsibility, including those of township treasurer, township trustee and school director. His wife was a devout member of the Methodist Episcopal church, having united with the same about the time the first class was formed in Lodi, this county. Sceva Chapman died January 21 1881 and Azuba Chapman died November 24 1885, at Lodi, Medina county, Ohio. Sceva and Azuba (Marsh) Chapman became the parents of six children, namely: Willard J., Harrison S., Ozias E., Arminda E., and Rozella M. Of this number two are now living- Ozias E., who lives at Ottawa, Illinois and Mrs. Rozella M. Topping of Sedgwick City, Kansas.

#### Harrison S. Chapman

Harrison S. Chapman, father of him whose name introduces this article (Chesley G. Chapman), was born on the old homestead farm

in Harrisville township, Medina county, Ohio, on the 26th of July 1830, and he was reared to manhood under the conditions and influences of the pioneer epoch so that his educational advantages were limited to the common schools of the locality and period. On the 20th of August, 1800, was solemnized his marriage to Miss Jane Gilley, daughter of Andrew and Catherine Gilley, who came to Harrisville township, this county, from Pennsylvania, in 1833, and who were prominently identified with the building of the first Congregational church in the village of Lodi.

Harrison S. Chapman devoted his attention to farming and stock-growing throughout his entire active career, and was one of the progressive agriculturists and highly honored citizens of the county. He passed his entire life, with the exception of one year, on the fine old homestead farm which had been secured by his grandfather so many years before and which at the time of his death one of the model farmsteads of the county, having been reclaimed from the forest and brought to its present fine state of productivity by representatives of this well known pioneer family. The old Chapman homestead was bought in ???? (not legible) by the Baltimore and Ohio Improvement Company, from which the gravel and timber were taken to make the large fill on the Baltimore & Ohio Railroad double track through the incorporated town of Lodi.

Harrison S. Chapman was a man of impregnable integrity in all the relations of life and he well merited the unqualified esteem and confidence reposed in him by the people of his native county. He was a Republican in his political proclivities, served for a number of years as school director and also gave effective service in the office of township trustee. He and his wife were zealous and consistent members of the Congregational church of Lodi, and he was recognized as one of the veritable pillars, having held the offices of clerk and deacon for about forty years and having been an earnest and well fortified teacher in its Sunday-school from the time he was seventeen years old until the close of his long and worthy life, except for the brief interval of one year.

He was summoned to the life eternal on the 8th day of May 1895, and she who had ever been his devoted wife and helpmeet and the gracious mother of his children, passed away on the 16th of October, 1901, secure in the reverent affections of all who had come within the sphere of her gentle influence. Of the two children Angie L. is the elder, having been born on the 24th of March, 1862, and become on March 14, 1889, the wife of Charles W. Daniels, of Harrisonville township, who was born March 10, 1864, at Apple Creek, Wayne County, Ohio. To them have been born three children, Crystal Belle Daniels, born July 9 1890; Joseph Harrison Daniels, born March 18, 1892; and Charles Elmo Daniels, born December 7, 1893. The younger child is the subject of this review and brief data concerning his career appear in the following paragraphs (omitted).

#### Chesley G. Chapman

Chesley G. Chapman was born on the old Chapman homestead farm in Harrisville township on the 10th day of July, 1867, and he is now owner of the valuable property in Chatham township, Medina county, known as the old Moses Parsons' homestead which has excellent improvements of a permanent nature, including a substantial residence. He is now recognized as one of the successful and essentially representative farmers and stock-growers of his native county and has a fine landed estate of one hundred twenty two acres.

Mr. Chapman, as may be supposed, was reared to the sturdy discipline of the farm, and to the district schools of the locality he is indebted for his early educational training. He continued to be associated in the work and management of the home farm until his marriage, at the age of twenty-two years, and he and his wife passed the ensuing year in the village of Lodi, since which he has followed farming and stock-growing.

Though never a seeker of public office, Mr. Chapman has shown a constant and lively interest in all that has tended to conserve the general welfare of his community and he is aligned as a stanch supporter of the cause of the Republican party. He is appreciative of the lives and labors of his forebears who have been so prominently identified with the development of this favored section of the Western Reserve, and has reason to be proud of the name which he so worthily bears. He retains in his possession as a valuable heirloom a well preserved deed to one hundred acres of land in Ashford, county of Windham, and colony

of Connecticut, transferred by John and Martha Stevens to his great-grandfather, Jonathan Chapman, under date of the 18th day of February in the eight year of his majesty's reign Anno Domini 1768.

On the 6th of February, 1890, was solemnized the marriage of Mr. Chapman to Miss Nettie C. Packard, who was born in Chatham township, this county, on the 13th of October 1869, and who is a daughter of William and Elizabeth (Parsons) Packard. William Packard was born in Plainfield township, in Hampshire county, Massachusetts, on the 18th of September, 1826, and died at his home in Chatham township, Medina county, Ohio, on the 16th of March, 1905, one of the successful farmers and honored citizens of the county.

His wife was born on the old Moses
Parsons homestead in Chatham township, Medina
county, on the 26th of March, 1834, and still
maintains her home in Medina county. Caleb n
Packard, the paternal grandfather of Mrs.
Chapman, was a native of Massachusetts, as was
also his wife, whose maiden name was Sallie
Stowell.

The maternal great grandfather, Moses Parsons, was a member of an old and honored family of New England and was one of the sterling pioneers of Medina county, Ohio, as has already been noted in a preceding paragraph. Darwin Parsons, grandfather of Mrs. Chapman, was a native of New York, as was also his wife, whose maiden name was Hope Crush. Mr. and Mrs. Chapman have nine children, whose names, with respective dates of birth, are here given: Harrison W., September 22, 1890; Chesley C., May 2, 1892; Lutie Belle, April 22, 1894; Hobart McKinley, March 17, 1896; Mabel R., August 22, 1898; Thelma M., November 3, 1900; Fenton C., March 10 1903; Mertrude L., July 9, 1905; and Keith E., February 19, 1909.

#### GEORGE CHAPMAN

George Chapman was born December 25, 1736- possibly in Virginia. He was killed by Indians in 1781 as he was on the way from North Carolina to Crab Orchard, Lincoln County, Kentucky. He is buried at Bean's Station, Grainger County, Tennessee. Bean's Station is about forty-five miles northeast of Knoxville. [Note: At one time some researchers though George was the son of Nathaniel and Mercy (Dennison) Chapman, Jr. The dates of several critical dates in the life of Nathaniel and Mercy and George do not fit.]

George married Diana DERRETT, in Spotsylvania County VA in 1755 or 1758. Diana was born 1737 in St. George's Parish, Spotsylvania, Virginia and she died June 27 1800 in Fayette County, Kentucky, where she had settled with her children. Diana was the daughter of Robert and Elizabeth (Goodloe) Durrett.

#### Children:

- i. Frances Diana Chapman born October 10 1759 in Spotsylvania County, Virginia (Christened November 10 1759), died June 3 1832 in Barren County, Kentucky, married James YOUNG May 23 1792 in Fayette County, Kentucky. James Young came from Dundee, Scotland to the British colonies in 1774 and resided at Yorktown, Virginia. He came to Fayette County Kentucky, married Frances, and they moved to Cumberland County in 1801. On account of the Indians they moved to Barren County on Peters Creek fifteen miles south of Glasgow where he died August 13 1821. They were buried on their home place. [Note. One account shows that Frances was divorced August 13 1821 in Barren County. Since that is the date of James' death date it is discounted.]
- ii. Elizabeth Chapman born October 10 1759 in Spotsylvania County, Virginia (Christened March 27 1761), died July 1840 in Barren County, Kentucky, married John ELLIS March 6 1794 (1802) in Fayette County, Kentucky;
- iii. Nancy Ann Chapman Christened May 7 1763 in Spotsylvania County, Virginia, married a THOMAS and moved to Illinois;
- iv. Margaret Ann Chapman Christened February 16 1766 in Spotslyvania County, Virginia, died between 1833 and 1846 in Christian County, Kentucky, married (1) Aaron W. HIGGINS May 2 1785 and (2) Charles THOMAS;
- v. George Chapman, Jr. Christened December 14 1770 in Spotsylvania County, Virginia, died September 14 1844, married 1800;
- vi. Mary "Polly" Chapman Christened July 25 1775 in Spotsylvania County, Virginia, died 1814, probably in Barren County, Kentucky, buried there on Nobob Creek, married Robert Lain (Layne or Lane) 1800.
- vii. Asa Chapman Christened July 2 1779, died July 12 1852, married Sallie GOSNEY November 5 1801 and had five (nine) children and moved away. [We have no names.]
