and Philip Ellsworth. Thomas Seim has already sent me his information. Do you have anybody else working on the WILLIAM CHAPMAN 1633 E line?

"I have a computer program that writes the book. All I have to do is enter the data. I am sending you a sample of the first two pages to what you think of it. I use BROTHERS KEEPER program which is a shareware program. It's the best one that I have tried."

Gil's Comments- Maybe you should add George A. Chapman of Florida to your list. See the article on CHAPMAN-CARRIER in this issue. Also add Marion G. Harcourt #097, 8426 Viburnum Court, Indianapolis, IN 46260- see her lineage in this issue. I agree with John on the computer program he is using. The output he sent was the very best I have ever seen from a genealogy program.

"I have one small bit of information to add to my WELLS ANDREW CHAPMAN family group sheet. I received his death record which stated that he died on Feb. 10, 1890 from heart disease, and 79 years. Then it went on to say he was born July 10, 1818, which cannot be right as he was 79 in Feb of 1890. The year should be 1810. Unfortunately, the death record did NOT give his parents' names. I still haven't gotten any concrete evidence that my Wells is the son of LEVI CHAPMAN and Lois Ackley, although I feel sure he is, & the month & year of his birth is right.

"Since Wells was affiliated with the Methodist Church, I am going to see if I can find anything on him in their archives.

"I will let you know if I come up with anything else. ..."

Darla sent a printout of the Chapmans in the LDS-IGI from North Carolina. It had been sent to her on a computer disk by a researcher in Salt Lake City. This came from a formatted text file on disk. When printed it consumes much paper. Those who have access to a LDS (Mormon) Family History Center that is equipped with a computer (many of them are) can copy from the LDS compact disks a variety of Chapman genealogical data. In addition to the format sent by Darla one can download or copy the data to what is called GEDCOM 2.01 format. With a conversion program (Shareware) called GIPSI, which I have purchased, a person one can convert this to a file compatible with my data base program. You will be seeing that in future issues, but after I've processed you cannot distinguish it from the data I have been publishing. Those who would like to have a Xerox copy of the 91 pages sent by Darla should send \$7.00 to cover the cost of reproduction and mailing.

Darla reminds us she is not making any progress on her WILLIAM CHAPMAN born about 1795 in Virginia who married Elizabeth FISHER. William was probably the son of ROBERT CHAPMAN who we estimate was born about 1775- maybe in Virginia.

"Well I think it is about time that I sit down and drop a line to you about my Chappie family lines.

"I had a very happy hunting in January 1991 at the Waltham Mass National Archives and the Mass Archives in So. Boston Mass.

"I started at Waltham looking for another family I was researching and became frustrated -- so I thought that I might as well go to the Champion Family of frustration- the Chapmans.

"I found in the 1900 census my Aunt Del living in Providence with her grandfather Patrick Daley. Well, I knew that Pat Daley was not her grandfather because he was my mother's uncle. So I went searching the 1880 census and found my Aunt Del living with Pat Daley and his wife Mary in Backstone Mass.

"Well, at the bottom of the census card there was a name that hit me between the eyes, it was my great grand mother, CATHERINE CHAPMAN. She was listed as mother-in-law of Pat Daley. What a surprise.

"I went to the Mass Archives in So Boston and found Catherines death record and also the marriage record of Patrick DALEY and MARIA CHAPMAN in 1861 in Blackstone Mass.

"Well I was on a roll. I found in 1870 that Catherine was listed with Pat Daley's family.

"In the year 1860- I found Catherine as head of family with Mary and John. Mary was born in Ireland and John in New York.

"In the year 1850- no record of this family in Mass- but in Monroe New York I found Mary and John with Catherine. Also a Patrick age 16 yrs. and two boarders.

"So I found my grandfather
JOHN CHAPMAN (no "H") in 1850 in
Monroe NY and 1860 in Blackstone
Mass. I then lost him until 1880 when
I found him in Dudley Mass married to
Bridget MOORE with 2 children. So
the search goes on.

"So I returned home and went to Raleigh N.C. LDS and started searching through their films. Well in New York State - the Monroe Census of 1845 shows PATRICK CHAPMAN (this is my great grandfather's name) but no other names. So I assume that between 1845 and 1850 he died or disappeared. The Patrick age 16 could be his son.

"I then found a film for Worcester County Mass and looked up Blackstone Mass for 1855. I found Cather-

Chapman data. I will be going to Salt Lake in May for research at the Family History Library. I'm still looking for data on Isaac et al!!"

Gil's Comments - Dorothy's direct Chapman ancestors were published in the 1989 CHAPMAN DIRECTO-RY. Her complete branch was published in CHAP-MAN LINEAGES VOL I.

ALAN P. SULLIVAN, JR., 8209 Blue Heron Drive East, Villa #4 Wilmington, NC 28405

He wrote in July "I read your notice in the Mar-Apr issue of the Genealogical Helper. Since I have some Chapmans in my family tree will you kindly send me information about your quarterly publication." I sent him some information and a blank Chapman Family Worksheet. He returned a pedigree form instead of the worksheet with the following comment: "I'm interested in Chapmans. ELIZA-BETH CHAPMAN (#1) married John SULLIVAN, and alleged linear ancestor of mine, and they allegedly had a son Benjamin b 1770. I have definite proof that Benjamin is my great, great, great grandfather. However, I have no definite proof that Benjamin was the son of John. Since Elizabeth Chapman might be the mother of Benjamin, maybe your Chapman records would proof this. If so, I could bring a Chapman branch up to date, right up to my grandson, if you're interested." The pedigree chart showed the following (1) ELIZABETH CHAPMAN born 17 Dec 1747 East Hadam, Middlesex, CT married 21 Feb 1766 (1768) New London, CT John SULLIVAN born February 28 1740, etc., (2) CALEB CHAPMAN born August 21 1704 East Haddam, Middlesex, CT married 11 Feb 1731 Elizabeth CHURCH, etc., (4) ROBERT CHAPMAN born 17 April 1675 Middlesex, etc. ... The following is my response to the above.

The pedigree sheet you sent with your July 24 letter is adequate for me to work with your Chapman

problem. I fear that any "help" I might provide at this time will be to "disprove" your tentative Chapman ancestry. Note that I put disprove in quotes because I don't have actual proof of the information I will supply you. My source for this information is Rev. F. W. Chapmans book on The Chapman Family published in Hartford Connecticut in 1854. It is generally accepted as a reliable source.

Your Chapman lineage tracks fine starting with the earlier Chapmans and coming down to Elizabeth Chapman born December 17 1747, the son of Caleb Chapman and Elizabeth Church. Elizabeth was actually their second daughter named Elizabeth—an earlier one was born 1738 and died 1740. Here is what the book has to say about Elizabeth:

"Elizabeth Chapman, daughter of Caleb Chapman, born at East Haddam, December 17, 1747, was married to Joseph Adams, Jr., of Canterbury, November 25, 1773. By him she had six children, and died in the year 1785, aged thirty-eight." It goes on to list their children and then this branch of the family dries up.

In the same book, but a supplement of sorts which list some Chapman branches, not part of the main Chapman family, I found an Elizabeth Chapman who married a John Sullivan. Unfortunately none of the children were named Benjamin but it may provide a clue for some further research on your part. The date of birth of her children suggest this might be the Elizabeth Chapman whose 21 Feb 1766/68 marriage to John Sullivan is listed in the LDS IGI. The following was taken from the book but is not verbatim. I've paraphrased it to make it easier to understand.

Elizabeth Chapman, married John Sullivan and had children: l. Jeremiah C., born August 27, 1768, died young; 2. Mary, November 9, 1772, who married Enoch Parsons; 3. Elizabeth, born December 1, 1773, who married Dr. S. H. P. Lee.

Elizabeth was the daughter of Gideon Chapman born November 1, 1704 who married Hannah Tabor. He died in 1739.

Gideon Chapman was the son of Jeremiah Chapman born 1670 who married a Hannah.

Jeremiah Chapman was the son of William Chapman who first appeared in New London CT records in 1657. We estimate he was born about 1633 in England. He died December 18, 1699.

I have information on several Elizabeth Chapmans who lived at about that time and in that general area who I've not connected with a spouse. If I had more information on your ancestor Benjamin Sullivan I'd know more about how much leeway I have in my search. I think I conclude from your last letter that you are not even sure that Benjamin's mother was named

Elizabeth. I think I also conclude that you do not have proof that "rejamin's nother was a Chapman. Are those conclusions correct?

As soon as I have a better appreciation for what we are looking for I'll include an inquiry in my Chapman newsletter.

Carol wrote- "I'm reluctant to write and cause you more confusion, but will try to be specific and concise.

"I wrote you 4 or 5 years ago and sent you some information on my CHAPMAN. Last year, I joined the ranks of "Chapman Chatter". When I joined, I sent a small amount of information on my family, thinking I had already sent you a Family Group Chart in the past. However, I see in the Winter 1991 issue #24 that you apparently only have information on

SAMUEL H. CHAPMAN and wife Sarah TRISLER and their daughter Fanny, as per page 12 of that issue.

"In the hopes it won't be too much trouble for you to add my Family Group information in some future issue, I'm sending you one with this letter. There may be a little more information now than I had 4 or 5 years ago, or perhaps I never sent you a chart back then.

"Sorry to give you more work, and I will understand if this information doesn't get into a "Chapman Chatter" for some time. I'm patient! It's a trait I've acquired from doing genealogy for so many years!! Thank you, and don't feel any need to answer this letter; I know how busy you must be."

Gil's Comments- Never apologize for sending me Chapman information which does create some "work" for me. Carol had written before- 1985, 1986 and 1991. With those I received a pedigree chart and an extract from a pedigree chart. I was pleased to receive the family group record and all of the information has been entered in the Chapman Biographical Reference with Carol's reference CJW-112. Carol's Chapman lineage was published in the 1989 CHAPMAN DIRECTORY and you may remember inquiry #7-187 published for her in February 1985. Remember she needs help with SAMUEL HOUSTON CHAPMAN born December 7 1812 in Ohio.

GIVINS-HALL FAMILY HISTORY

recently noticed advertisement in a 1973 issue of THE GENEALOGICAL HELPER for the above named family history. It was a 700 page book dealing with many families of Southwest Virginia and areas westward. A number of related families are mentioned including CHAPMAN. Would you please check the libraries to which you have access to see if you can find this book. If you do please extract the Chapman information for me.

THE CHAPMAN FAMILY

The most extensive Chapman reference I have ever seen is Rev. F. W. Chapmans THE CHAPMAN FAMILY: or the Descendants of ROBERT CHAPMAN one of the First Settlers of Say-Brook, Conn., with Genealogical Notes of William Chapman, Edward Chapman, John Chapman, and Rev. Benjamin Chapman. published 1854 in Hartford, CT.

A reprint of this book which originally had over 400 pages with index is being offered by Higginson Books for a price of \$40 plus \$3 postage and handling. It was previously \$62. The reprint is a hard bound (buckram) 8 1/2 X 11 book.

Since I have never purchased anything from Higginson's I cannot wouch for the quality of their reprints or their service. They do advertise regularly in THE GENEA-LOGICAL HELPER.

Harold was one of those persons who made contact with us on the computer service - PRODIGY. Should you need to contact him on that service his ID# is TRGG70A. Information on Harold's Chapman line is in Chapman Lineages and some data received from him is in the Chapman Biographical Reference listing in this issue.

The significant thing about the contact with Harold is the fact that he made us aware of an article on the origin of Robert Chapman who was born in 1616. The information comes from THE AMERICAN GENEALOGIST, Jan 1991, Vol 66, No. 1 in an article by Dr. Dorothy Chapman Saunders "The Origin of ROBERT CHAPMAN of Saybrook, Connecticut - A Theory Nipped in the Bud". I must be careful in citing this article as I do not want to violate their copyright.

Dr. Saunders first states the family tradition "Robert Chapman, one of the founders of Saybrook, Conn., in 1635, (1) was the son of a soap-boiler in Hull, Yorkshire, England, and (2) had a brother who 'perished in the wars in Flanders.' It also says that (3) his mother was a Puritan who wised to emigrate but his father would not leave Hull, and that (4) she induced Robert, aged 18, and his three sisters to go to the New World . . . " She cites Rev. F. W. Chapman's 1854 book on the Chapman family and an item not known to us-Mary Walton Ferris' DAWES-GATES ANCESTRAL LINES [n.p. 1931-43]. She goes on with some of the family tradition "One of Robert Chapman's sisters, generally called Rebecca, is said in 'an ancient document held by the Bushnell family but not now obtainable' to have married William Bushnell of Saybrook.

Dr. Saunders related some of her experience some years ago researching this subject for a month in London and Yorkshire, England. She did find a baptismal record in Kingston upon Hull for a Robert Chapman who appears to be our Robert. The document gave the name of the mother but not the father. She also found

some information through her local Family History Center.

Her conclusions are that—"ROBERT CHAPMAN, merchant of Kingston upon Hull, Yorkshire, died according to his probate records, before 11 Jan. 1620 . . . He married first in Holy Trinity Church, Kingston upon Hull, in Jan. 1589/90 ELIZABETH WILLIAMSON, who was buried in Holy Trinity Church in Aug. 1610. He married second, in Beverly, Yorkshire, in 1615 ALICE ROBINSON . . . she died before 22 Oct. 1633, according to her husband's probate."

She goes on to discuss Robert's estate and then lists his children. The known children by the first wife were Elizabeth baptized 1591, Ann baptized 1594, Judith baptized 1596 and Mary or Marie baptized 1600. The only known child of the second marriage was ROBERT CHAPMAN baptized January 1 1616/17.

Dr. Saunders did not find evidence of a Rebecca Chapman, but she admits that the list of children of Robert Chapman of Hull may be incomplete.

Later evidence leads Dr. Saunders to conclude that another person must have been the mother of Robert Chapman. Court records of May 1651 cited an action by the mother of Robert Chapman and identified her with a son in new England. That then suggests that Robert Chapman of Hull probably was not the father of Robert Chapman, born 1616.

Dr. Saunders Chapman lineage is as follows: Dorothy Elizabeth Chapman Saunders 1912, Rev. Adelbert Chapman 1854, Berkley Chapman 1831, Rev. John Sheather Chapman 1797, Caleb Chapman 1764, Capt. Elisha Chapman 1740, Deacon Caleb Chapman 1706, Nathaneal Chapman 1653, Robert Chapman 1616.

More complete information on Chapmans from this account is included in the Chapman Biographical reference.

John CHAPMAN³ (John², William¹ 1633 New London, CT) born @ 1680 in New London, CT, died ?? (Colchester, CT), married Sarah CARRIER (not CARVER) September 7, 1707 at Colchester, CT. She was born November 17, 1684, at Billerica, MA and died December 6 or 7, 1772 (Colchester, CT). She was the daughter of Thomas and Martha (ALLEN) CARRIER.

Thomas CARRIER, als MORGAN, born it is supposed, about 1626 in Wales; died Colchester, CT, May 16, 1735; married May 7, 1674, Martha ALLEN, born @ 1650; died August 19, 1692, daughter of Andrew and Faith (INGALLS) ALLEN of Andover, MA. Children: Richard, Andrew, Jane, Thomas, Sarah, all born at Billerica, MA, and Hannah,

born at Andover, MA.

Savage's "Genealogical Dictionary of New England" says that Martha (ALLEN) CARRIER was the victim of a horrible delusion and that Richard, with his sister (Sarah) of 7 years old, were witnesses in the unnatural proceedings at the Salem Witch Trials against their mother that bore them, as they also were against Rev. George Burrows, who was convicted and hanged at the same time with her, for the same imaginary crime that ended in the execution of their mother 19 Aug 1692.

CARL H. CHAPMAN SN 0&699509 (Odd serial number is not correct. Maybe the & should be 7 -Gil), Second Lieutenant, Army Air Corps, U. S. Army, from Missouri, was reported taken prisoner in Austria July 8 1944. He was imprisoned at a camp in Barth-Vogelsang, Prussia and was liberated June 5, 1945.

DONALD W. CHAPMAN SN 37593753 Private, Infantry, U. S. Army was reported taken prisoner in Germany December 9 1944. He was imprisoned at a camp in Moosburg, Bavaria and was repatriated on January 16 1946.

ERNEST CHAPMAN SN 31411409 Private First Class, Infantry, U. S. Army was reported taken prisoner in Germany December 16 1944. He was imprisoned at a camp in Muhlbert, Sachsen and was repatriated March 6 1946.

FRANK L. CHAPMAN SN 35934017 Private, Infantry, U. S. Army was reported taken prisoner in Germany December 16 1944. He was imprisoned at a camp in Nuremburg, Bavaria and was liberated May 8 1945.

FRANKLIN W. CHAPMAN SN 0&429603, Captain, Army Air Corps, U. S. Army was reported taken prisoner in Germany November 13 1944. He was imprisoned at a camp in Barth-Vogelsang, Prussia and was liberated June 9 1945.

GLENN D. CHAPMAN SN 01177327, Second Lieutenant, Field Artillery, U. S. Army was reported taken prisoner November 23 1944. He was imprisoned at a camp in Schubin, Poland and was liberated July 3 1945.

HAROLD L. CHAPMAN SN 32502903, Staff Sergeant, U. S. Army was reported taken prisoner in the European Theater April 30 1945. He was imprisoned at an unknown camp and was repatriated March 13 1946.

JOE D. CHAPMAN SN 37534106, Sergeant, Army Air Corps, U. S. Army was reported taken prisoner in Germany December 17 1944. He was imprisoned at a camp in Sagan-Silesia, Bavaria and was repatriated March 6 1946.

LET'S TALK

I suppose I spend more time reviewing Chapman biographical and historical data than any other person around. I've not done it enough to consider myself an authority but I have begun to form some ideas. The ideas actually don't pertain to Chapman but to genealogical data in general.

For the past ten years that I've been collecting this information I've taken the attitude that I'd never complain about how folks send me information - as long as they send it. I can see now that it would be to your advantage for me to share with you some of the ideas I've gotten while reviewing the information you send.

Let's Talk Places

Do you ever send folks genealogical material without providing them information on the location? Collectively you have sent me information on Chapmans of the US, Canada, England and Lord knows where else. Would you believe though than many have sent information with absolutely no reference to a place. I know there are many times when one just doesn't know where the suspect ancestors were located—if that is the case then the paper you prepare ought to be so annotated. If you think you know where they were then there should be some notation as to the suspected or supposed location.

Some have sent information in which the counties were listed but with no reference to the state. That sure doesn't make my job any easier when there are 50 different states.

If at all possible when I enter data into the computer I try to show a location for at least one event- birth, death, marriage, burial, spouses birth or spouses death. Unfortunately I do not always pass that on to you- especially in the text part of the newsletter. I'll try to improve on that.

Town vs County

When you are doing research how often do you go to the records of the town or city hall? How often do you go to the records of the county? It seems to me that in 98.9% of the cases we direct our search at county records. Why then do most of you enter the town or city name when you

enter a location on a record? Why don't you enter the place where you searched or where you are hoping someone else will search.

You may not have noticed-but to the extent possible I always show the state and county for locations. I generally use a technique which has the official post office two character abbreviation for the state followed by a four letter abbreviation for the county. In most cases it is the first four letters of the county. When that would create ambiguous or duplicate county abbreviations in the same state then I devise an alternate. The alternates, for all states, are published as an appendix in 1989 CHAPMAN DIRECTORY.

It will pay dividends!

If you really want folks to help you in return for the information you send to them then do them the courtesy of giving as much geographical reference as you can. If you think it is important that they know the town or city tell them, but also identify the county if you can.

Really you ought to send a prospective helper everything you know about a person when you are seeking their assistance. You never know when a related name, place, or date will be the clue that permits them to make some connection for you.

In that regard you ought to have your information organized and fixed so you don't have to write it from scratch every time you want to send information to a friend seeking their help. The best way to do that is to have the information recorded on a good family group record (and I don't mean a lot of the half-baked forms output from many of the dinky genealogy computer programs). I know- you don't have enough information to justify putting it on a form. What is enough? If you have a name that is enough. Keep the original in a safe and clean place and add to it as you get new information. Use black ink (not blue ink or pencil) as you make additions. You can then make photocopies of this precious original and send them to friends as you have the need. If you want to buy family group records and don't know where- let me know. If you just want to borrow a few tell me.

CHAPMAN LAND RECORDS

To the extent that I have the information available I plan to include a page of Chapman land information in each issue. If you have any Chapman land information I'd appreciate it if you would send it to me.

Mrs. Hofmann has compiled several outstanding books containing North Carolina Land Records. If you would like to purchase one let me know and I'll send you more information. Maybe you would like to purchase one and let me use it long enough to extract the pertinent information.

These would have been grants from Lord Granville to the first person listed. All come from Patent Book 11. The first number is the item number from Mrs Hofmann's book. The page number refers to the page in the Patent Book. OR=Original Record, SCC= Sworn Chain Carrier.



Lynn Davis was born on May 7, 1936 at Cook County Hospital in Chicago, Illinois.

She was transferred to St. Vincent's Adoption Agency on May 14, 1936 and was placed with adoptive parents, Robert & Loretta Joy in June of 1936. Lynn was able to obtain her original birth certificate in 1987.

Birthmother's name was Marie (Chapman – maiden name) McCallum. According to birth certificate, Marie was separated from Thomas McCallum who was listed as Birthfather. Marie was 23 and her Birthplace was New York. Thomas was 24 and his Birth place was Texas. Marie was a singer and Thomas, a musician.

Birth certificate shows that Lynn was second child born to Marie. It is not known where or when sibling (or half sibling) was born or whether that child was male or female. Marie would have been born in approximately 1912 or 1913 in New York. Thomas would have been born in approximately 1912 or 1913 in Texas.

Unfortunately, the birth certificate shows only birth state of parents, so it is not known whether Marie was born in New York City or New York State and there is no county or city in Texas listed for father.

Sibling probably would have been born in the early 1930's. Adoption Agency has told Lynn that her parents were or Scotch-Irish & English descent.

Lynn has learned that her mother had been in Chicago two years prior to her birth and was of the Protestant Faith. Her address in Chicago, Illinois in 1936 was 4869 Kenmore and also 4943 Kenmore. Both of these addresses were large hotel-type apartments. There is no record of a marriage or divorce of Thomas and Marie, nor were they registered as voters in Cook County.

Lynn's adoptive parents died when she was very young and she has always wanted to know who her biological family is or was, especially, her mother and sibling.
